

Notifying the committee of any accident or incident in your group

Notifying the committee of any accident or incident that occurs within your group/s, other than the very trivial is important. Doing so provides Beeston u3a with a record of the accident/incident should there be a public liability claim now or sometime in the future.

This notification should be a brief outline of the accident/incident, which will enable the committee to advise whether any further information or action is required.

Beeston u3a's public liability insurance is provided by the Third Age Trust's insurers. The relevant policy is written to protect all u3a members and includes 'member to member' cover. This means that if a member is injured undertaking a u3a activity and legal liability could be proven against another member, the insurers would deal with it. This includes group facilitators, in the possible but hopefully unlikely event that a claim was made against them personally for damages following an incident in their group.
